On October 28, 2011 Supplementary Letters Patent (Form 8) were issued to FRIENDS OF COVEHEAD-BRACKLEY BAY LTD and Charitable Status was awarded by the Federal Government and ratified by the PEI Minister responsible for the Companies Act and signed by Deputy-Minister Curley.

The main change: Article V, Schedule "A" of our original letters patent dated November 29, 2001 was deleted and replaced by the following charitable purposes:

To organize or participate in environmental projects designed to preserve and protect flora and fauna; preserve, protect and restore rivers; or improve the ecological condition of Covehead-Brackley Bay.

To educate and increase the public's understanding of the environment and its importance by offering courses, seminars, conferences and meetings and by collecting and disseminating information on that topic.

To conduct research relating to the environment and to disseminate the results of such research.

The dissolution clause under Article 16 has been amended to read as follows

Upon the dissolution of the corporation and after payment of all debts and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed to or disposed of to charities registered under the *Income Tax Act* (Canada)
