Accountability

Crew members will work under the direction of the Watershed Coordinator and Stream Supervisor to carry out their assigned duties in the watershed.

Duties: Stream enhancement and watershed restoration activities such as....

- Installation of brush mats, digger logs, stone pools, etc
- Removal of debris in and around streams
- Planting of trees, shrubs
- Restoration of springs
- Shoreline restoration
- Assisting with water testing, fish and wildlife surveys
- Assisting with public and educational events
- Other as required

Qualifications:

- For positions funded by the PEI Employment Development Agency, interested candidates must be registered on the EDA list. The registration information is on the PEI Government web site at http://www.gov.pe.ca
- Background in biology, wildlife, environment, or other relevant field preferred
- Stream enhancement experience preferred
- Must observe safety regulations and directives by Supervisors
- Must be able to work cooperatively with others
- Should enjoy outdoor environments
- Should be able to handle physical tasks such as lifting and walking for extended periods in various outdoor habitats fields, woods, streams, etc.
